About HealthInfoNet & Maine's HIE

HealthInfoNet is an independent nonprofit information services organization that manages the state of Maine's statewide Health Information Exchange (HIE). The HIE is designed to link an individual's critical health information from unaffiliated healthcare locations to create a single electronic health record. This allows authorized providers across the state to better support patient care.

Core HIE Participant Services

Electronic Health Record Services

Shares the HIE's longitudinal electronic medical records in a secure, view-only screen at the point care via multiple access methods:

Clinical Portal

A web-based platform that provides end users with a robust toolkit to make their workflows more efficient and care coordination activities more seamless. Includes patient lookup, electronic medical record, and community information services.

HINcontext Application

A SMART on FHIR EHR-certified application embedded within providers' EHR system clinical workflows with the objective of returning and displaying the HIE's information most conveniently.

Custom EHR Integrations

Other HIE integration methods are possible upon participants' request, including SAML, PBL, and other available standards.

Intelligent e-Notifications

Provides real-time alerting of time-sensitive events that make it possible for clinicians to establish the right care plan at the right time.

Note: This service can be use to meet CMS's e-notification CoP rule.

Notifications commonly of interest include when patients are admitted/transferred to or discharged from inpatient or emergency department settings; when patients' new documents, radiology reports, or laboratory results (including COVID results) become available; or when patients have been reported deceased.
