TOP USE CASES & INTERVENTIONS

01

Inform acute care illness and injury assessments.

- Retrieve critical information on patients' healthcare activities throughout the state
- Enhance patients' confidence and satisfaction with informed decision-making

02

Promote improved communication and coordination.

- Enhance and expand communication methods and data accessibility across systems of care
- Facilitate patients' transitions of care based on ailment severity and necessary follow-ups
- Educate patients on appropriate use of services based on personal health record reviews

03

Incorporate walk-in care treatment plans within longitudinal health records.

- Share important diagnostic and preventive health services information with the HIE that patients increasingly receive exclusively through walk-in care settings
- Give patients' care teams complete views into their patients' activities at walk-in care settings
