

## HealthInfoNet Access Available for Behavioral & Opioid Health Homes at Reduced Cost

Maine DHHS has partnered with HealthInfoNet, operator of the statewide Health Information Exchange (HIE), to offer <u>Behavioral Health Home (BHH)</u> and <u>Opioid Health Home (OHH)</u> organizations reduced costs to access and/or share information through the HIE Clinical Portal.

The portal gives participating providers the ability to securely retrieve **real-time health record information** and receive **real-time alerting of time-sensitive events** such as emergency room visits, critical lab results, hospital discharges, and other events of care that make it possible to intervene early and establish the right care plan for their clients.

## **Benefits of Using HealthInfoNet**

- Improves care coordination among providers and intervention during high-risk events of care
- Identifies and reduces gaps in care
- Helps clients transition between different types of care and providers
- Provides a true "team approach," as clients have the comfort of knowing that their entire treatment team has access to their critical health information
- Reduces burden on the client to remember and communicate information to various providers

## **Reduced Cost to BHH & OHH Organizations**

Through this offering, BHH and OHH organizations can take advantage of a **one-time \$2,500 implementation fee**\* and a reduced **\$1.00 per unique client per year annual subscription fee** (with a minimum annual fee of no less than \$750).

For example, if an organization served 500 patients in the previous fiscal year, then their first annual HIE subscription will be \$750.
