Patient Talking Points

Interested in having a discussion with your provider about HealthInfoNet? Here are a few questions to start the conversation...

Do you use HealthInfoNet's systems?

If your provider is unfamiliar with HealthInfoNet or isn't sure if their organization participates with HealthInfoNet, tell them they can contact HealthInfoNet to learn more by visiting www.hinfonet.org/inquiries.

How do I know if my health information is being shared with HealthInfoNet?

If your provider says that your general medical and/or sensitive health information is not being shared with HealthInfoNet, you can ask about how you can change your consent choice to share your information ongoing.

How does reviewing my HealthInfoNet record inform the care you provide to me?

You can also ask what type of information in your HealthInfoNet record is most helpful to your provider in informing their care decisions and plans.

How can I be more engaged with my HealthInfoNet record?

Your HealthInfoNet record should serve as a dialogue between you and your provider. Ask how your HealthInfoNet record can be used to improve your patient care experience.

The three services HealthInfoNet offers to your providers include:

- **Clinical Portal**: An electronic health record system that shares your data at the point of care
- Notifications: An email-based service that sends alerts about your time-sensitive health events
- Analytics: A suite of reporting dashboards that curate information about your health outcomes, risks, conditions, and drivers
